### The Sky for Kids

A live exploration the motion and patterns of the daytime and nighttime sky just for our youngest learners!

Recommended for: children ages 5 and younger, and their families, Length: ~20 minutes

### Habitat Earth

Plunge below the ocean's surface to explore the dynamic relationships found in deep ocean ecosystems; dig beneath the forest floor to see how Earth's tallest trees rely on tiny fungi to survive; and soar to new heights to witness the intricate intersection between human and ecological networks.

Recommended for: ages 7+, Length: 25 minutes

### Oasis in Space

Water: our most precious resource. Without it, life could not exist on Earth. Is the reverse also true? If we search for water, will we also find life? In this fulldome film, we explore our solar system and discover what makes our world stand out among the Sun's family of planets.

Recommended for: ages 6+, Length: 24 minutes
